

NHS Bylaws

1. NHS members must maintain a GPA of 92 or above. Failure to do so will result in the student being placed on NHS probation for one semester. During the probationary time, parents will be notified and the student and advisors will develop a plan for the student to improve their GPA. If the student does not meet the requirements of the plan, they may not be inducted or they may be removed from the NHS.
2. 80% attendance of mandatory events is required for all NHS members. Students who do not have 80% attendance prior to the induction ceremony may not be inducted. Excused absences include absence from school, college visits, school trips which do not return prior to start of NHS event, and sporting events for which the student must leave school prior to start of NHS event. Absence from event due to work is not excused. Notice of an excused absence should be submitted to the advisors via email.
3. Members are expected to maintain high standards of service, leadership, and character throughout the school year. Discipline referrals may result in NHS probation and/or membership review.
