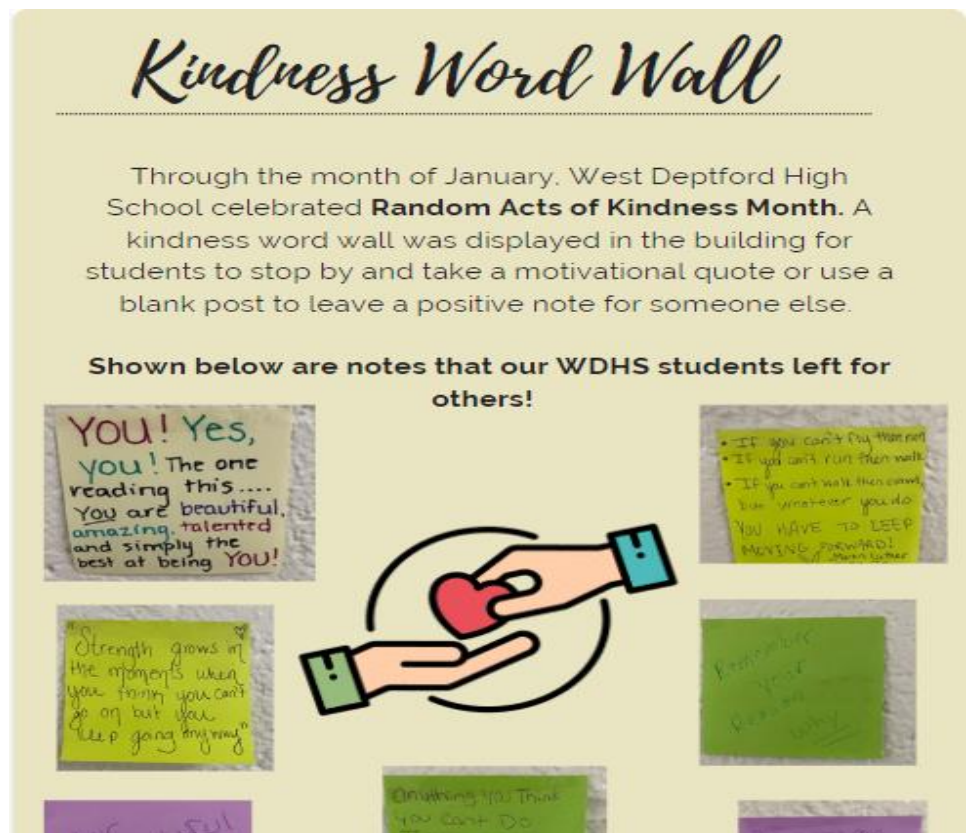
## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

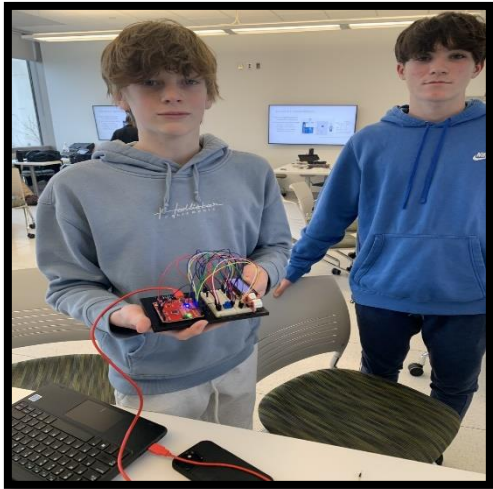
### **Cutler-Bell Prize | Computer Science Teachers Association**

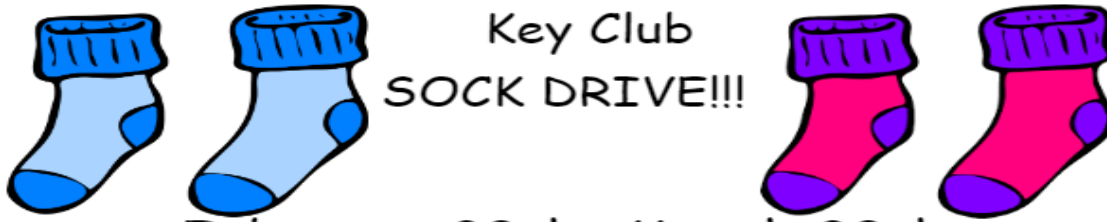


**Academic Challenge NEEDS YOU!**
