The week of March 13th-16th **ALL** 11th graders will be taking the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA). This is a standardized test given by the State of New Jersey, required for graduation. Students are unable to opt out of this graduation test; if students do not take the test they may be ineligible for a high school diploma. Students will be measured in the standards of English Language Arts and Mathematics over the course of these four days.
