I need to extend a HUGE thank you to our entire West Deptford Community today! As you know, we encountered an unsubstantiated phone threat to WDHS. The students and staff were immediately evacuated according to our practiced "drill/plan". To say the kids were awesome would be an understatement! So, thank you to our students – first and foremost – for their calmness and for their respect of their teachers as they provided direction. Secondly, thank you to the high school staff and fellow administrators at the high school, as well as across the district, who assisted in the efforts to ensure the safety of our students at all times during this situation. I appreciate the swiftness with which everyone responded to the directions given. In times like these, it is easy enough to give in to panic, but that did not occur today. Lastly, thank you to our first responders and our parents! Our WDPD and support emergency services acted very quickly in ascertaining that the threat made today was unsubstantiated. Parents, thank you for your patience as we worked through this situation today. As always, the safety of our kids is paramount and we will do everything to ensure their protection.






FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH


In the upcoming weeks, some of our members will be preparing for the **Consumer Bowl**, a quiz bowl competition using consumer knowledge and testing for the State Conference.




Mr. West Deptford will take place on Wednesday, February 15, at 7 pm. Come out and cheer for these gentlemen as they put on a great show!!!
