### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Parents,

In the coming weeks, students will be involved in **both NJSLA statewide testing as well as AP Testing** at the high school. On **Monday, May 1, and Tuesday, May 2**, WDHS will operate on a "delayed opening" schedule. On these two days, 9<sup>th</sup> graders, select 10<sup>th</sup> graders, and 11<sup>th</sup> graders will attend school normally at 715am. However, most 12<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders will be able to come to school on the "delayed schedule." A second round of buses will come to the bus stops to pick the students up on these two days. A good rule of thumb is that on delayed opening days, the bus driver will come three hours later than its normal pickup time. The bus drivers will remind the students of this as we get closer to May 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. All non-testing students will need to arrive to school by 10:15am on these two mornings.

More details about which students are testing and where they will need to report will be coming out next week. Please stay tuned and stay alert for those details.

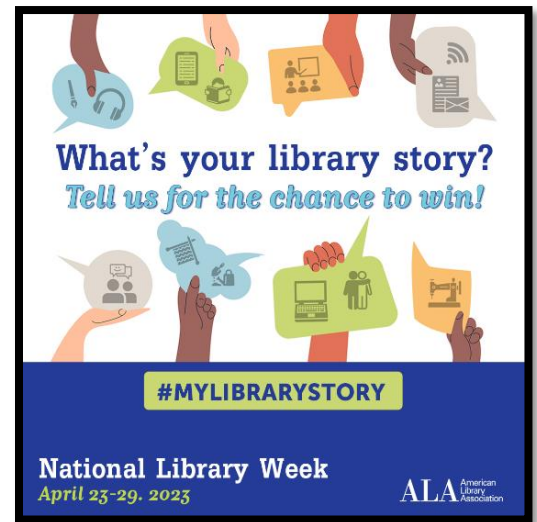
## NATIONAL LIBRARY WEEK
