



POSSIBLE COURSE FAILURES

- <u>Failure Warning Letters</u> were recently emailed home to parents/guardians of any student in danger of failing a course for the year.
- Course failures can result in retention, ineligibility for sports and activities, and prolonged time in high school.
- Students in danger of failing a class are encouraged to make up missing assignments and discuss an improvement plan with their teacher. Students should also develop a study plan for final exams, as these count as 10% of their total course grade.



SUMMER SCHOOL Credit Recovery Option:

GCIT (Gloucester County Institute of Technology, Sewell) will host a summer school program this year.

- Students MUST earn <u>a minimum final grade of 50</u> in their WDHS class to participate.
- Students may take up to 2 courses only.
- Students <u>must attend in person at least two days per week</u>. The rest of the work may be completed online.
- Registration opens on June 12.
- Registration MUST be completed online at www.gcit.org/summerschool.
