1. Juniors who are thinking about 4 year colleges and universities should register to take the SAT and/or ACT this spring. Students received handouts with all the test dates, registration deadlines, registration information, etc. back in December during their college planning classes.
2. Parents of seniors who plan to attend college in the Fall, 2016 are reminded that the FAFSA needs to be completed in order for students to access any financial aid, student loans, and in some cases, scholarships. Go to <https://fafsa.ed.gov> to complete the FAFSA. Deadlines to file vary by college and university. Beware of sites that charge you a fee. The "real" FAFSA is FREE so be sure you go to the correct site! RCGC will be hosting FAFSA workshops for families in Gloucester County who may need help completing the form. Your child does NOT have to be attending RCGC in order for you to participate. Dates should be released soon at [www.rcgc.edu](http://www.rcgc.edu).
3. Seniors are reminded to update their Naviance accounts to let us know where they have been accepted and where they plan to attend, once they make that decision!
