NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

ATTENTION PARENTS OF THE CLASS OF 2016, 2017, 2018, and 2019

The New Jersey State Department of Education has just released an **update** to their graduation requirements for your children. As you may know, there has always been a state testing requirement as a part of the graduation requirement for each New Jersey High School. When the NJ State Department elected to join the federal 'Achieve' initiative along with other states, they chose at that time to switch our standardized test from the HSPA to the PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers). Since the PARCC is a new test of record, the State Department wants the transition period – the next few years – to be as smooth as possible. To this end, your children are being given multiple opportunities to meet his/her state test graduation requirements.

If your child is enrolled in an English I, II, or III course <u>and</u> an Algebra I, Geometry, or Algebra II course, he/she will be required to take the PARCC assessments for these respective courses each year. However, the State Department is providing some leeway in the requirement to pass all of these assessments for the fulfillment of the graduation requirement. In short, if your child passes only 1 of these 3 assessments in both English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics, the requirement will be fulfilled regardless of the year your child took and passed the test. If he/she passes the English requirement in year 1, they still have to take the English II and III test but it will not be held against them in order to meet their graduation requirement. The same would be true for Mathematics. Similar to the HSPA, your child will be required to prove proficiency in both ELA and MATH in order to earn his/her diploma.

The NJ State Department of Education also recognizes that many of our students may have bypassed these aforementioned courses by the time they are required to take them in the next couple years. For example, those students in Math Analysis or Calculus will not be required to take a MATH PARCC assessment. He/She will be able to fulfill their state test graduation requirement via one of the following:

Note: * SAT taken prior to March 2016; ** PSAT taken prior to October 2015. The College Board will establish new 'cut scores' in December 2015 for the new PSAT and in May 2016 for the new SAT.

Again, this is the NJ State Department of Education's transition plan for the "test of record fulfillment" as it pertains to the Graduation Requirements for the Classes of 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019. The class that donates the most underwear will be awarded the coveted UNDERWEAR TROPHY.


