### Principal Notes:

First week of PARCC was a great success! We had almost 500 students a day successfully participate in the test. All students enrolled in the following courses - English I, II, and/or Algebra II – are required to take the PARCC assessment for that course each year they are enrolled in said courses.

Next week, WDHS students enrolled in these above courses will take the PARCC assessment. In order to ensure optimal testing conditions for those students who will be testing each day, there will be a delayed opening for all other students who are NOT testing.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT:

**COURSES FOR NEXT YEAR!** In addition to the orange course selection sheet that we ask parents to review, sign, and return to guidance, the guidance department is mailing home a second notification of the courses your child has selected for next year. Please review this list carefully. No changes can be made after May 1<sup>st</sup>. If your child still has not returned their signed orange course selection sheet, please remind them to do so ASAP.



Students who need **WAIVERS** in order to take classes for which they were not recommended or did not meet the course pre-reqs must attend a **Waiver Meeting on Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup> during HR.** The waiver process will be explained and waiver forms will be given out at that time. All waivers must be submitted by May 1<sup>st</sup>. No late waivers will be accepted.

**Two Summer Personal Finance course options are available.** One will be offered by WDHS at no cost and the other will be a college level course offered by RCGC for approximately \$150. Students will earn 3 college courses for the RCGC Personal Finance course as well as satisfy their high school requirement. Interested students need to see their guidance counselor ASAP.

**Juniors who are thinking about 4 year colleges and universities should register NOW to take the SAT and/or ACT.**

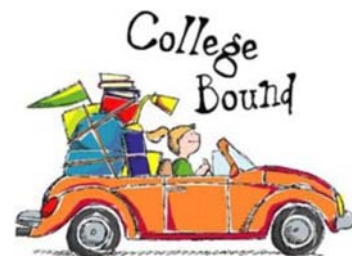


**SATs:** The deadline to take the May SAT is Friday, April 7<sup>th</sup>.

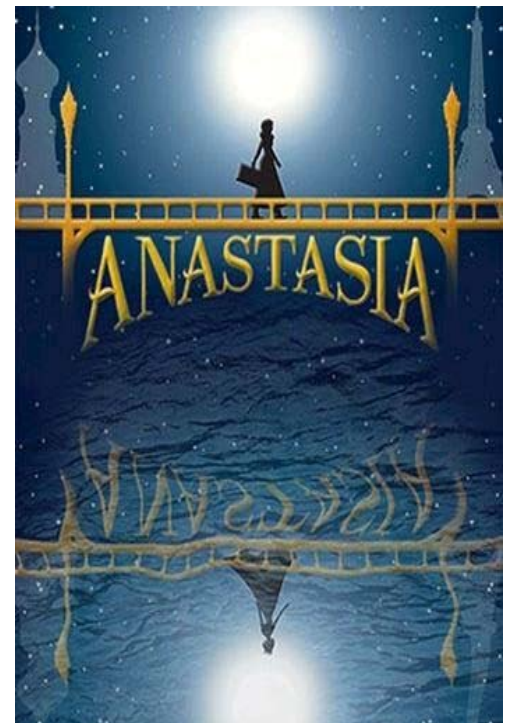
### French News

## WEST DEPTFORD SAFE SPACE:

GLSENs Day of Silence is a national day of action in which "students from middle school to college take a vow of silence to encourage schools and classmates to address the problem of anti-LGBTQ behavior by illustrating the silencing effect of bullying and harassment on LGBTQ students and those perceived to be LGBTQ" (<https://www.glsen.org/day-of-silence>). **Why do we need a Day of Silence?**



The GLSEN 2015 National School Climate Survey found that a vast majority of LGBT students experienced verbal harassment with scores of students also experiencing sexual and electronic harassment. More than 30% of students report missing at least a day of school in the past month out of fear for their personal safety. Students are most often harassed at school for personal characteristics such as actual or perceived sexual orientation and gender expression. Thus, the Day of Silence helps bring us closer to making anti-LGBT bullying, harassment and name-calling unacceptable in U.S. schools.
