Principal Notes:

PROM TICKET INFORMATION (11th/12th grade) - New this year – every student attending the PROM must access and submit an online electronically signed permission slip by April 24. THIS IS A NEW WAY TO PREPARE FORMS AND COLLECT PAPERWORK. The forms are found on the West Deptford High School webpage. Click on ‘access electronic permission slip’ to get into the Google Form. Once the student signs the form, the prom committee will check to see if fines are paid. Once process is completed, students will receive a note during homeroom which includes the date, time and location to pick up their ordered prom tickets. Once they receive this note, they are to bring the money to purchase their prom ticket.

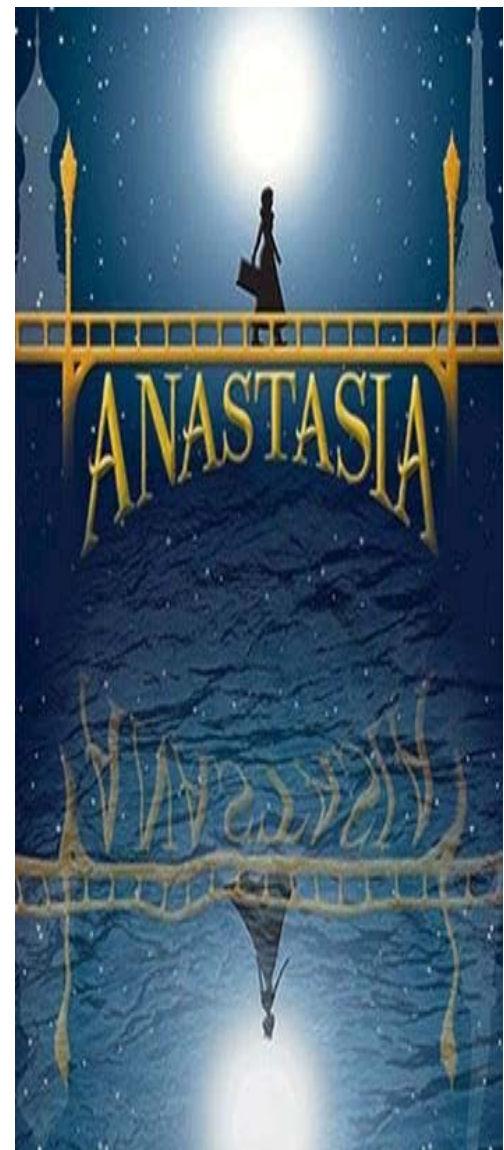
