NOTES:

- ❖ Everyone must report on time for each exam and also to homeroom for attendance every day.
- ❖ Students that are late to school will not be permitted to enter an exam after it has already begun.
- ❖ Students are required to stay in the exam testing room until the scheduled testing time is complete.
- ❖ There will be a scheduled make-up exam day on Tuesday, January 31st with a proctor in LGI/Media Center. Otherwise, students can arrange a make-up date with their individual teachers.
- ❖ **IMPORTANT** - Students that have a lunch/study hall exam period are permitted to leave during that designated period ONLY if they have written permission from a parent. This permission must be sent to the Attendance office **in advance**. We strongly suggest that students use their study hall/lunch exam period to study for additional exams. ALL students must sign into homeroom each day.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT:



1. **Did you know???? All students ages 15 and up can take college courses while in high school at a 60% reduced tuition rate at RCGC!** Take advantage of this low cost option to get a jump start on earning college credits! Schedule an appointment with a **RCGC Advisor who will be here @WDHS on Jan. 31st.** See guidance for more info
2. Good luck on mid-terms this week! Parents should keep their eyes out for **Semester 1 Report Cards will be distributed later next week.**
3. All **Sophomores** will participate in **Guidance Classroom Lessons next Tuesday, Jan. 31st.** Counselors will show students how to use **Naviance**, an on-line career and college planning tool. Students will also complete career interest surveys and learn about careers that match their personal interests.
4. **Sophomores and Juniors** are encouraged to log into Collegeboard to view their **PSAT scores** and link to a free on-line personalized tutorial program through **Khan Academy**. Students who are having trouble logging in or creating a Collegeboard account should schedule an appointment with their counselor.
5. **Sophomores** will have the opportunity to take advantage of a Guidance Dept. "Walk-in- Wednesday" later in February to get assistance with accessing their PSAT scores and understanding what they mean. Stay tuned for more info!
6. **Juniors** who are thinking about 4 year colleges and universities should **register to take the SAT and/or ACT this spring.** Students received handouts with all the test dates, registration deadlines, registration information, etc. back in December during their college planning classes.
7. **Seniors** are reminded to **update their Naviance accounts** to let us know where they have been accepted and where they plan to attend, once they make that final decision!
8. **Seniors planning to attend RCGC: Over 100 scholarships are posted on RCGC's website.** Apply today at www.rcgc.edu/scholarships. Don't miss out on free money! See your guidance counselor if you need help!
9. **Parents of seniors who plan to attend college or a trade school in the fall: Have you filed your FAFSA yet?** Many schools have **January 31st priority deadlines** so do not delay and get that FAFSA filed!
