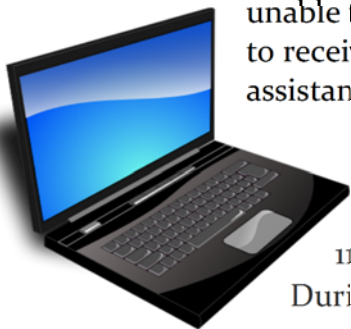
NOTES FROM THE PRINCIPAL

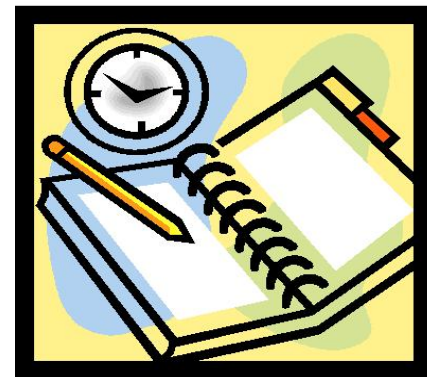
