





ENGINEERING CLASS NEWS



This week **Ian Kruithof, WD Class of 2017**, spoke to our Engineering Classes about his **Systems Engineering** job at **Lockheed Martin's Moorestown Facility**. Mr. Kruithof works on the **next-generation Virtual Aegis system**. Aegis is the **Navy's most modern surface combat system built to defend against air and surface threats.** It can be mounted on a ship which then can protect a group of naval ships in its vicinity from an attack.

Mr. Kruithof answered questions posed by the students on a variety of topics, including his high school and university education, whether his internships were beneficial, why he became an engineer, how hard it was to get hired at Lockheed Martin, his physical work environment, how he found a mentor, what a typical day is like, and also how lan gets help on an engineering problem when he gets stuck.

He **explained** his **systems engineering job** using Lockheed's Systems Engineering "V" Chart, which showed students all the job types **open to a systems engineer**. The

engineering classes thanked Mr. Kruithof for taking **the time to share his engineering experiences**. His presentation is attached here:


